## Puppy Kindergarten

*For puppies 10 weeks to 5 months:*

Through consistent reinforcement and praise, your dog will be introduced to the basic commands of sit, down, come, stay, watch, leave it, settle and will learn loose leash walking. This course also addresses common problem areas such as potty training, chewing, biting, digging and barking. Social and handling skills learned at a young age help puppies grow into well adjusted adults in new situations. The bond of trust and understanding will last a lifetime.

## Adult Obedience – Basic I

*5 months or older:*

Train your dog in a real life situation and your dog becomes reliable in real life situations. By the end of class many dogs have learned basic commands such as sit, down, come, stay, watch, leave it, settle and loose leash walking. This class also covers common problem areas such as potty training, chewing biting and digging. Consistent training at home will reinforce the skills they have learned in class.

## Adult Obedience – Basic II

*For basic obedience graduates:*

The emphasis in this class is on reliability, working with distractions and continuance of skills learned in Basic Obedience I. We will also practice more advanced skills such as heeling with turn/pace changes, long down stay, long sit stay, sitting politely for petting and many more.

## Advanced Obedience

*For basic obedience I & II graduates:*

This class will cover remote commands and off-leash work.

## Adult Obedience – Advanced

*For basic obedience graduates:*

The goal for students in our advanced class is off-leash obedience. We will also practice more advanced skills such as down-on-recall and out-of-sight down-stays.
